Christ Died . . . 1 Peter 3:18

Greek for "died" means "to suffer."

- Examples are:
 - Matthew 4:24
 - Acts 9:16
 - 2 Corinthians 11:23-29
- Suffering is the theme of 1 Peter

- The Greek word hapax means "once and never again."
- Christ's death forgave _____ sins.

Just For The Unjust 1 Peter 3:18

- Christ was sinless
 - Hebrew 4:15
 - 1 Peter 2:22
 - 1 John 3:5
- Christ traded places with believers.
- Christ bore our sins (1 Peter 2:21)

He Might Bring Us To God 1 Peter 3:18

Synonymous with "go to heaven" or "be saved"

Habakkuk 1:13

Put To Death & Alive In The Spirit 1 Peter 3:18

- This is how He accomplished it.
- Fleshly body died but not His spirit
 - Matthew 27:501
