

#### Feast of Passover

Leviticus 23:4-5

- v. 4 echoes v. 2
- v. 5 month for feast is Nisan 14
  - Nisan was the first month of year
  - time was twilight
  - celebrated redemption in Egypt



#### Feast of Passover

Leviticus 23:4-5

- v. 4 echoes v. 2
- v. 5 month for feast is Nisan 14
  - Nisan was the first month of year
  - time was twilight
  - celebrated redemption in Egypt
  - Symbolizes the death of Messiah
  - The Lord's Supper mimics the Passover

# Feast of Unleavened Bread

Leviticus 23:6 - 8

- v. 6 Nisan 15
  - Unleavened no sin or evil
- v. 8 7 days of sacrifices and feasting
  - On 1<sup>st</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> days no hard work

### Feast of Unleavened Bread

Leviticus 23:6 - 8

- v. 6 Nisan 15
  - Unleavened no sin or evil
- v. 8 7 days of sacrifices and feasting
  - On 1st and 7th days no hard work

The feast symbolizes the perfect sacrifice and as a result no decay of Christ's body.

## Feast of First Fruits

Leviticus 23:9 - 14

v. 10

- Nisan 16
- Sacrifice of first fruit of wheat harvest

- v. 12-13
- offer several offerings

- Sacrifice of first fruit of barley harvest

v. 12-13

offer several offerings
Symbolizes first of the harvest
Symbolizes Jesus resurrection (1
Cor. 15:20,23)

## Feast of Pentecost

Leviticus 23:15 – 22; Deuteronomy 16:9-12

v. 15

- Seven weeks later (Deut. 6:8)
- First fruits of the wheat harvest

v. 16-22

- 50 days after the Sabbath that preceded the Feast of First Fruits
- offerings made

Symbolizes arrival of the Holy Spirit
