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
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Predicate Nominative

- A second nominative acts as an adjective

ὁ λόγος ἦν θεὸς (English text)

- Here is the actual Greek word order



John 1:14

Only Begotten

Only begotten

- *μονογενής* = “*only, only one, unique one*”
- *Hebrews 11:17*
- *Genesis 25:2-11*

John 1:30

“He Existed Before Me”

Before

- ***πρώτος*** = “*first in a series*”

Matthew 1:23

“Call His Name Immanuel”

His name is Immanuel

- **Quotes Isaiah 7:14**
- **Immanuel = “God with us”**

Gospel of John

John 8:24

Jesus said, “I AM”

I am He

- **No Greek word for “He” in the passage.**
- **The Greek is ἐγώ εἰμί**
 - **This is an emphatic “I AM”**
- **Exodus 3:14**

John 8:58-59

Jesus said, “I AM”

I AM

- *The Greek is ἐγώ εἰμι*
 - *This is an emphatic “I AM”*
- *Exodus 3:14*

John 10:30-36

Jesus Declares He Is God

- “*I and the Father are one*”
 - *The Greek for one is εἰς*
 - *This is the cardinal number 1*
 - *It means Jesus and the Father were 1.*
- *Notice the Jewish leaders understood what Jesus claimed - verses 31-33.*

John 10:35

Jesus Said I Am the Son of God

- “**Son of God**”
- ***Notice that Jesus defines the meaning of “Son of God” as One who is God.***
- ***Verse 31 makes it clear the Jews understood that was the meaning.***
