



Characteristics of a Wise Man

Eagerly seeks wisdom Prov. 1:5

Turns away from sin Prov. 3:7; 14:16

Restrains his anger Prov. 14:16; 29:11

Open to rebuke Prov. 9:8-10

Works hard Prov. 6:6-11

O.T. - How To Be A Wise Man

Psalm 111:10 says . . .

Fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom

One who obeys His commandments gains more wisdom (NLT)
