### "Definition of Faith"

- Definitions** - "certainty, oath of fidelity, proof, security, confidence, trust, conviction, assurance, and guarantee" - TDNT, Kittel
- "persuasion, conviction, commitment, confidence which is expressed in human relationships as fidelity, assurance, oath, proof, and guarantee" - TLNT, Spicq
  - "think to be true" - Thayer's Lexicon
