faultless”***

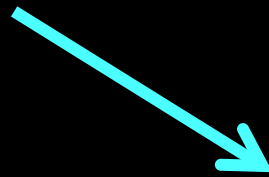

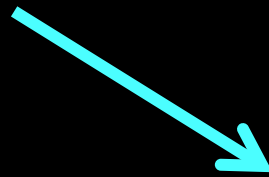

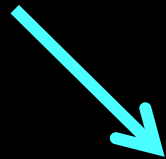
