HAYA = “to be”

In The Beginning God Created . . .

Genesis 1:1

*The earth was **formless** and void,
and darkness . . .*

TOHU = “without form”

In The Beginning God Created . . .

Genesis 1:1

*The earth was formless and void,
and darkness . . .*

BOHU = “void or empty”

Hebrew Word Translated As “Day”

Genesis 1:5

<i>YOM . . .</i>	<i>2,301 times</i>
<i>Evening & morning</i>	<i>38 times</i>
<i>YOM + evening & morning</i>	<i>23 times</i>
<i>YOM + evening</i>	<i>52 times</i>

. . . always refers to 24 hr. period
