Common Bond

Verse 9

“Brother”

. . . expression in the N.T. for Christians

- Prayed Together***
- Loved***
- Supported***
- Cared For***
- Helped***

Common Bond

Verse 9

“Fellow partaker - Tribulation”

. . . refers to John's imprisonment and punishment

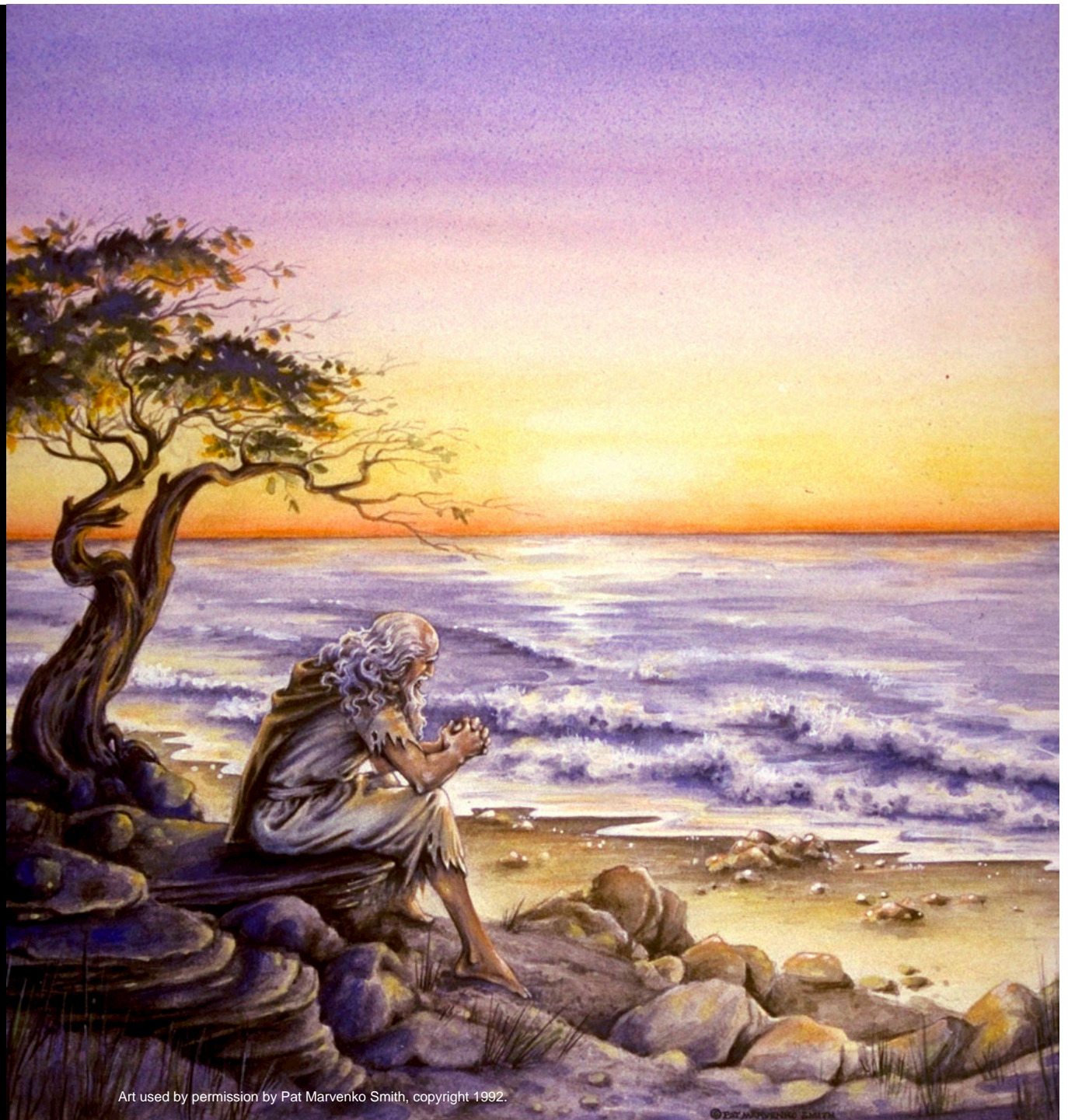
- During reign of Roman Emperor Domitian***
- Domitian reigned A.D. 81-96***
- Christians persecuted***

. . . John was banished to the Island of Patmos

Common Bond

“Kingdom . . .”

“Fellow partaker . . . In the Kingdom”

. . . refers to existing spiritual kingdom (John 18:36)

- Every believer is a member (Col. 1:13)

. . . Reminds us of 2 Peter 1:20-21

“Lord’s Day”

. . . Common 2nd century expression for Sunday

- Used by secular people***
- Used by Christians***

The Vision of Jesus – 8 Descriptions

- 1. Body . . . Long Robe and Golden Girdle***
- 2. Hair . . . white as snow***
- 3. Eyes . . . like a flame of fire***
- 4. Feet . . . like burnished bronze***
- 5. Voice . . . like the sound of many waters***
- 6. Right Hand . . . Holding seven stars***
- 7. Mouth . . . sharp two-edged sword***
- 8. Face . . . like the shining sun***

A Peek At Jesus

Verse 13

1. Long Robe and Golden Girdle

. . . Garments High Priest wore (Ex. 28:4, 31-43)

. . . Josephus states,

*- High Priest tied his garments together
with a sash*

Verse 14

2. Hair . . . white as snow

. . . White or gray hair spoke of wisdom

. . . Leviticus 19:32; Proverbs 16:31 and 20:29

Ultimately Wise and Holy**

Verse 14

3. **Eyes . . . flame of fire**

. . . Eyes speak of God's ability to see everywhere

. . . Flame of fire speaks of judgment

. . . Hebrews 4:13; Matthew 10:26; Jeremiah 16:17

**Picture That God Sees
Everything, Including Sin**

A Peek At Jesus

Verse 15

4. Feet . . . burnished bronze

. . . A king's subjects bowed at his feet

. . . Burnished bronze spoke of judgment

. . . Psalm 8:6; 110:1; Romans 16:20; Rev. 2:18

Verse 15

5. Voice . . . sound of many waters

. . . Loud voice often refers to God

. . . Ezekiel 43:2; Matt. 3:17; John 12:28; Heb. 12:26

Verse 16

6. Right Hand . . . held the 7 stars

. . . Right hand is a symbol of authority & control

. . . Exodus 15:6, 12; Psalms 89:13; 98:1

7. Mouth . . . sharp two-edged sword

. . . Broad, large, sword for cutting and piercing

. . . Revelation 2:12, 16

8. Face . . . shining like the sun

. . . God is light

. . . Matthew 17:1-6; John 9:5; 12:46; 1 John 1:5

. . . First and Last

. . . Living One

. . . Controls Death and Hell

- Decisive Victory At The Cross (Heb. 2:14)

- End of the War After His Second Coming (Rev. 20:7-10)
