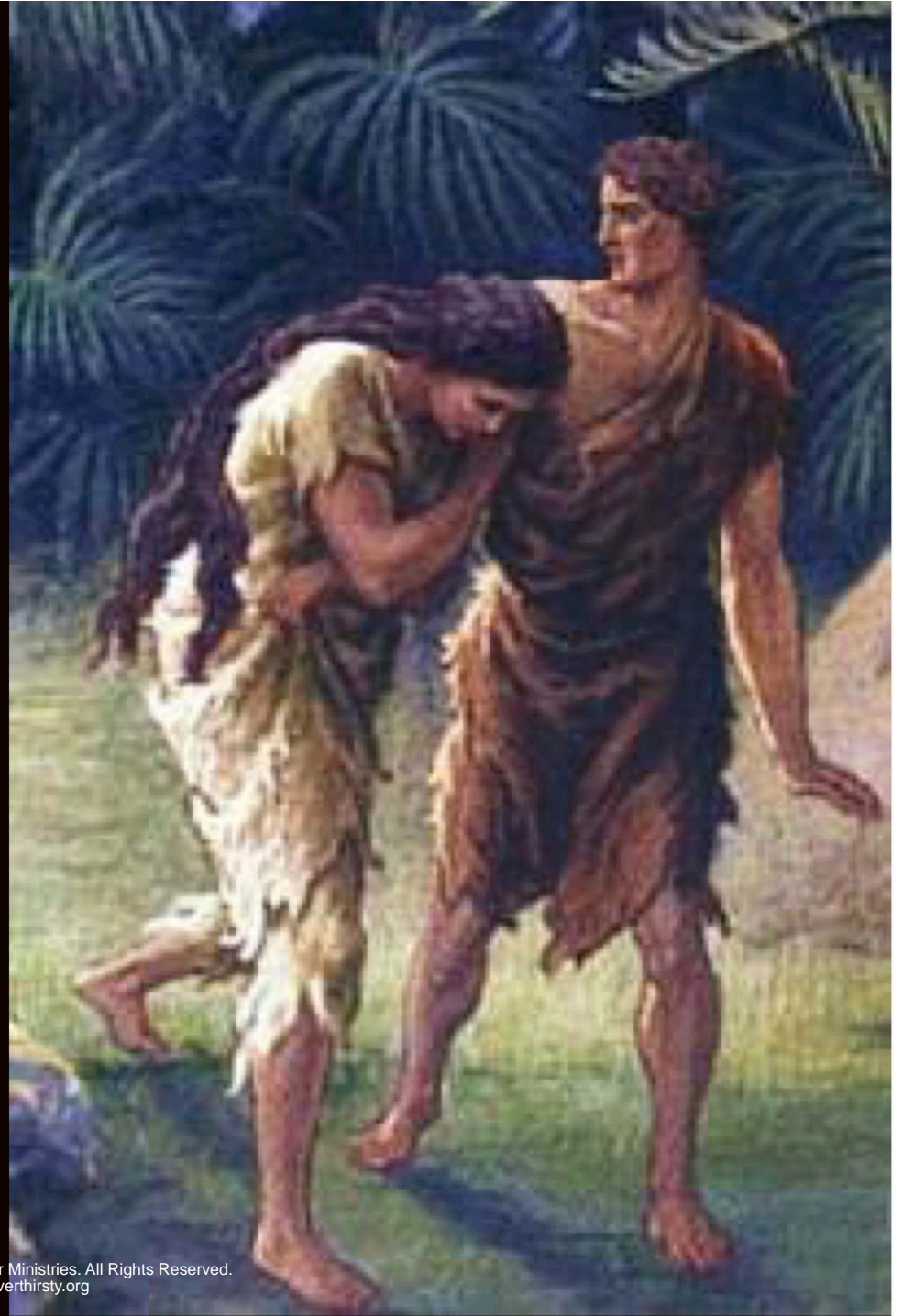


***When Adam

Romans 5:12-18



WE THE PEOPLE of the
insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defense
and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution.

Article I.

Section 1. All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 2. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors of the most numerous Branch of the State Legislature.

No Person shall be a Representative who shall not have attained to the Age of twenty five Years, and been seven Years a Citizen of the United States, and who shall not, when elected, be an Inhabitant of that State in which he shall be chosen.

Representatives and direct Taxes shall be apportioned among the several States which may be included within this Union, according to the actual Enumeration of the People, including those bound to Service for a Term of Years, and not taxed, three fifths of all other Persons. The actual Enumeration shall be made within three Years after the first Meeting of the Congress, and within every subsequent Term of ten Years, in such Manner as they shall by Law direct. The Number of Representatives shall not exceed, three fifths of all other Persons. The actual Enumeration shall be made, the States of New Hampshire eight, Massachusetts eight, Rhode Island and Providence Plantations five, Connecticut five, New York six, New Jersey seven, Pennsylvania ten, Delaware six, Maryland six, Virginia ten, North Carolina five, South Carolina five, and Georgia three.

Each State shall have at least one Representative; and until such Enumeration, the States of New Hampshire, Massachusetts, Rhode Island and Providence Plantations, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Delaware, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Georgia shall have the same Number of Representatives as they had in 1790.

The House of Representatives shall be the sole Power of Impeachment.

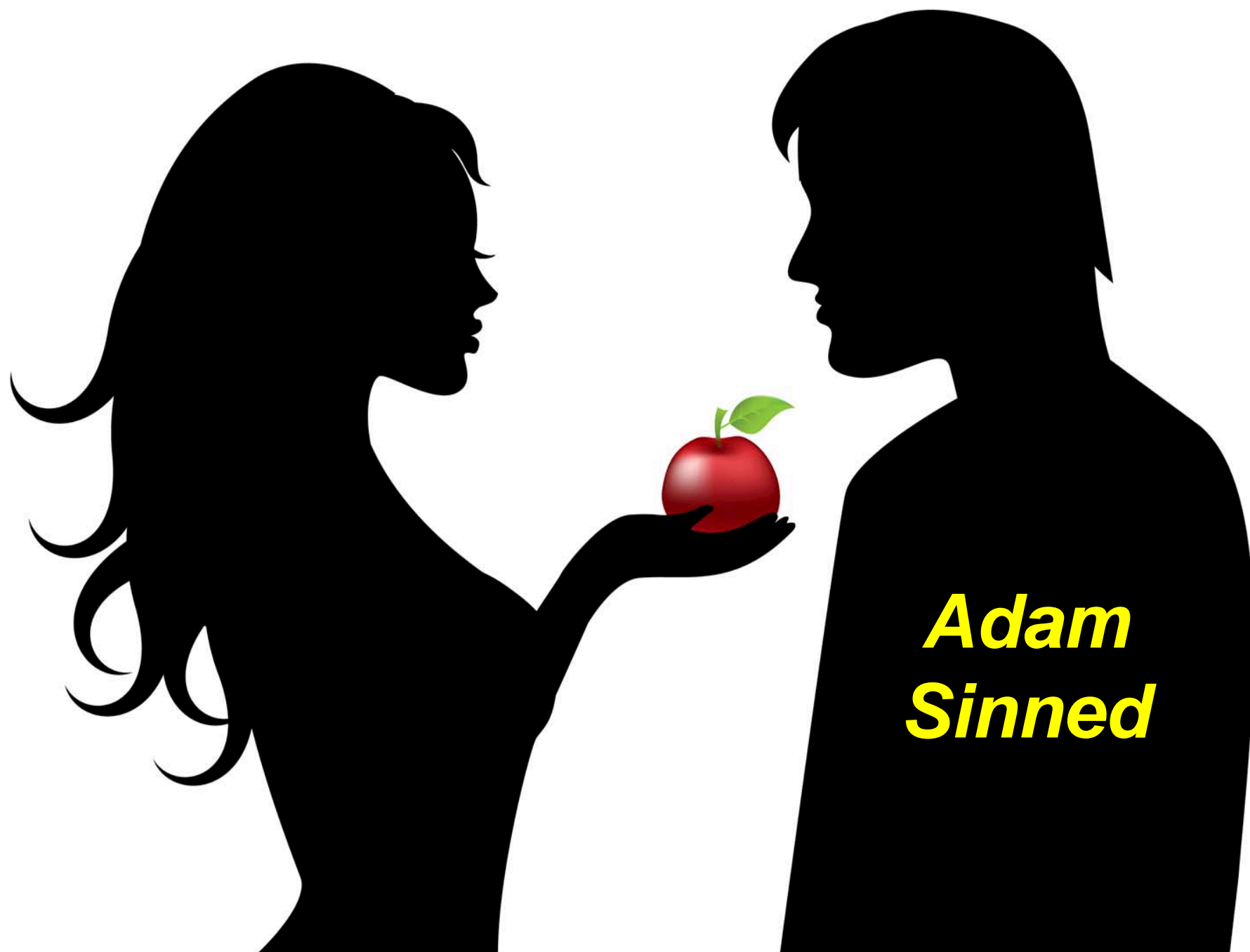

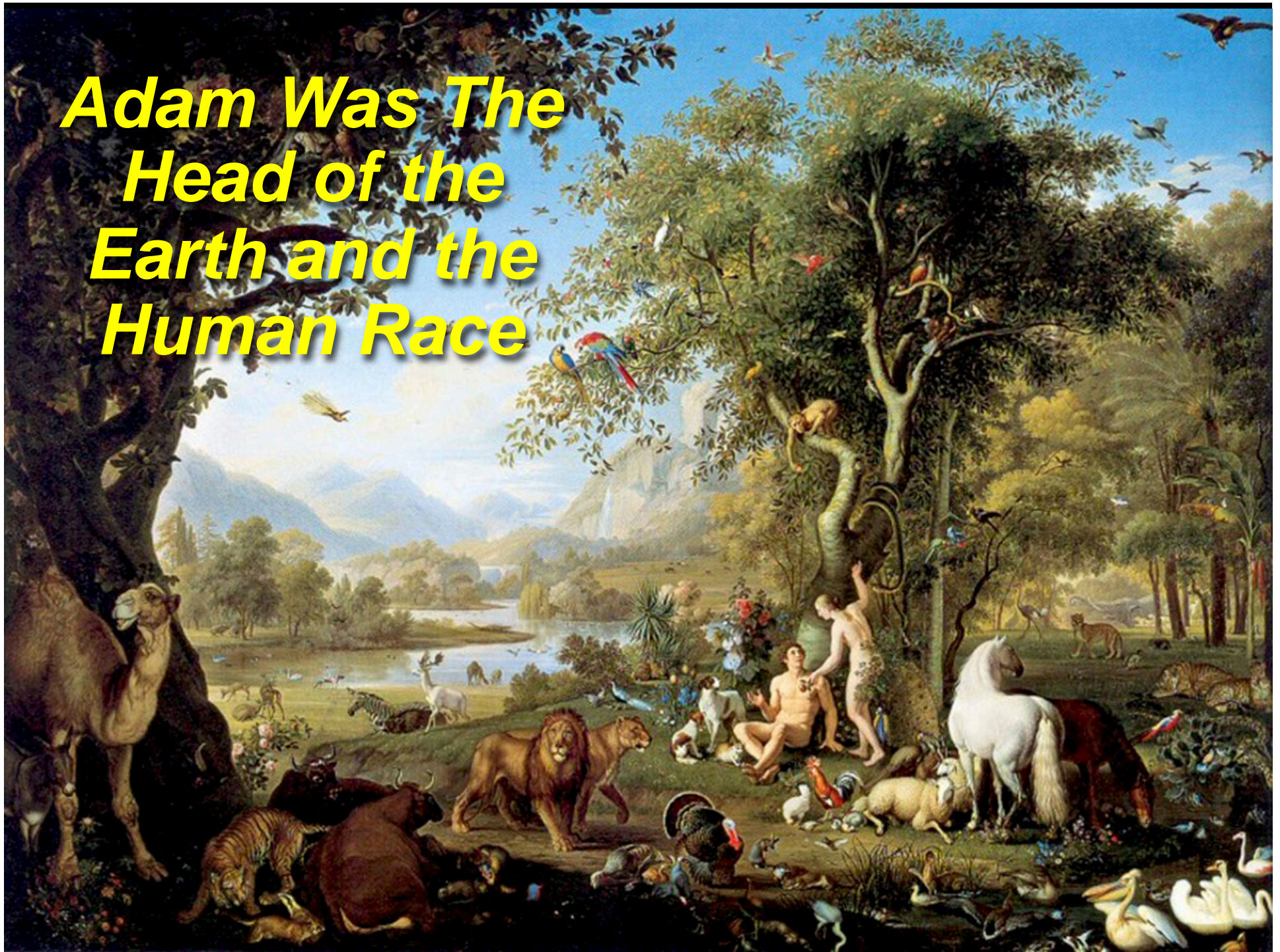
