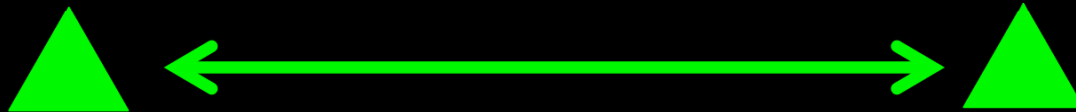



You Are Free From Sin

Romans 6:6 - 7

- ***Old man was:***
 - ***Crucified***
 - ***Rendered idle . . . Inactive***
- ***No longer **needs** to sin***

*Everyone who **practices sin** also
practices lawlessness; and sin is
lawlessness. You know that He
appeared in order to take away sins;
and in Him there is no sin.*



1 John 3:4 - 5


***You do what you
want to do!***

No one who **abides** in Him **sins**; **no**
one who **sins** has seen Him or
knows Him.

1 John 3:6

present participle

*Little children, make sure no one
deceives you; the one who **practices**
righteousness is righteous, just as
He is righteous; the one who
practices sin is of the devil . . .*



1 John 3:7-8

present participle

No one who is born of God **practices** sin, because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.

1 John 3:9

present participle

We Live Together With Jesus

Romans 6:8 - 11

- ***We live together with Christ***
- ***We will never die again***
- ***Therefore, live to God***

***. . . so consider yourselves to
be dead to sin, but alive to God
in Christ Jesus.***
