

"Able To Teach" - Elders Only

Apt to Teach - διδακτιχοσ:

"skillful in teaching" - Leading Greek Lexicons, J. Calvin

"highly skilled teacher" 2 - J. MacArthur

"one qualified to teach" - A. T. Robertson

"not merely given to teaching, but . . . skilled in it" - K. Wuest

"'Apt to teach' includes both the willingness and the skill and ability to teach. 5 - D. Heibert

Elders must be skilled in teaching the Word and they must know the book.

This is not casual, lifestyle, or academic teaching.

Apostle's Priority - Teach & Shepherd

Acts 6:1-2, 4

Now at this time while the disciples were increasing *in number*, a complaint arose on the part of the Hellenistic *Jews* against the *native* Hebrews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving *of food*. So the twelve summoned the congregation of the disciples and said,

"It is not desirable for us to neglect the word of God in order to serve tables . . . But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word."





Principle From Acts 15

- Unanimous Decision Reached



"It seemed good to . . ."

- Unanimity comes by the Spirit.
- Requires Spirit-filled elders.
- Disagreement means that either an elder is in sin or the Spirit is not in the decision
- Principle is found in Rom. 12:16;15:5; 1 Cor. 1:10; 2 Cor. 13:11


