

Reminds us of Genesis 22:9-14


Abraham And Isaac

John 10:18




1st Concern – Someone Against Us? Romans 8:32

2nd Concern – Who Can Charge Us? Romans 8:33



Reminder we are already justified

2nd Concern – Who Can Condemn Us? Romans 8:34

1 John 2:1

- Jesus is our advocate
- Advocate means "helper"
- He defends forever!

3rd Reason – Who Can Separate Us? Romans 8:35-37

"who"

TIS = "who or what"

3rd Reason – Who Can Separate Us? Romans 8:35-37

- Will difficulties separate us?
- No!

4th Reason – Conclusion Romans 8:38-39

Nothing . . .

Will separate us from the love of God

Nothing can separate us from God's love:

- Not my sin
- No accuser
- No trials
- Nothing else
