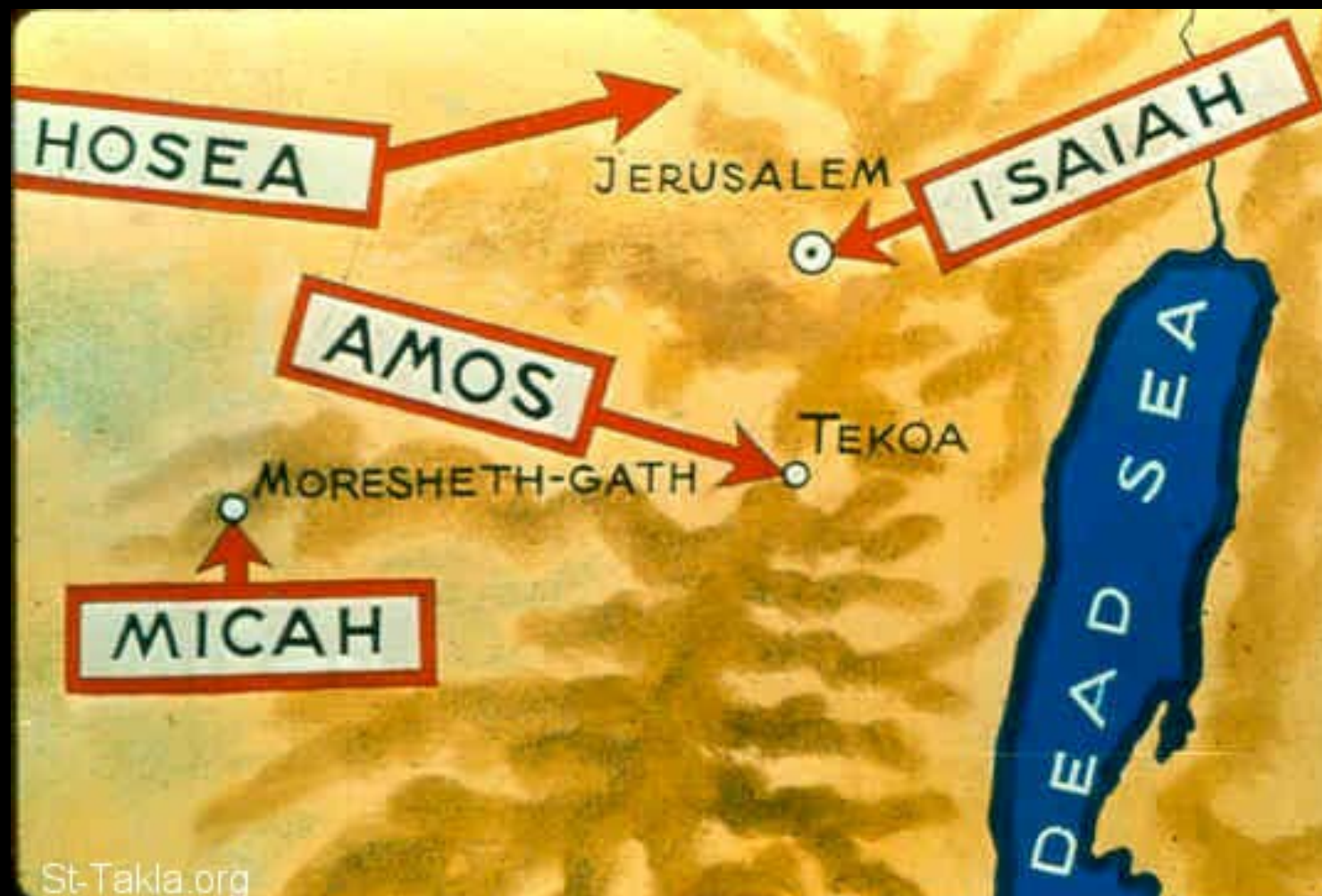

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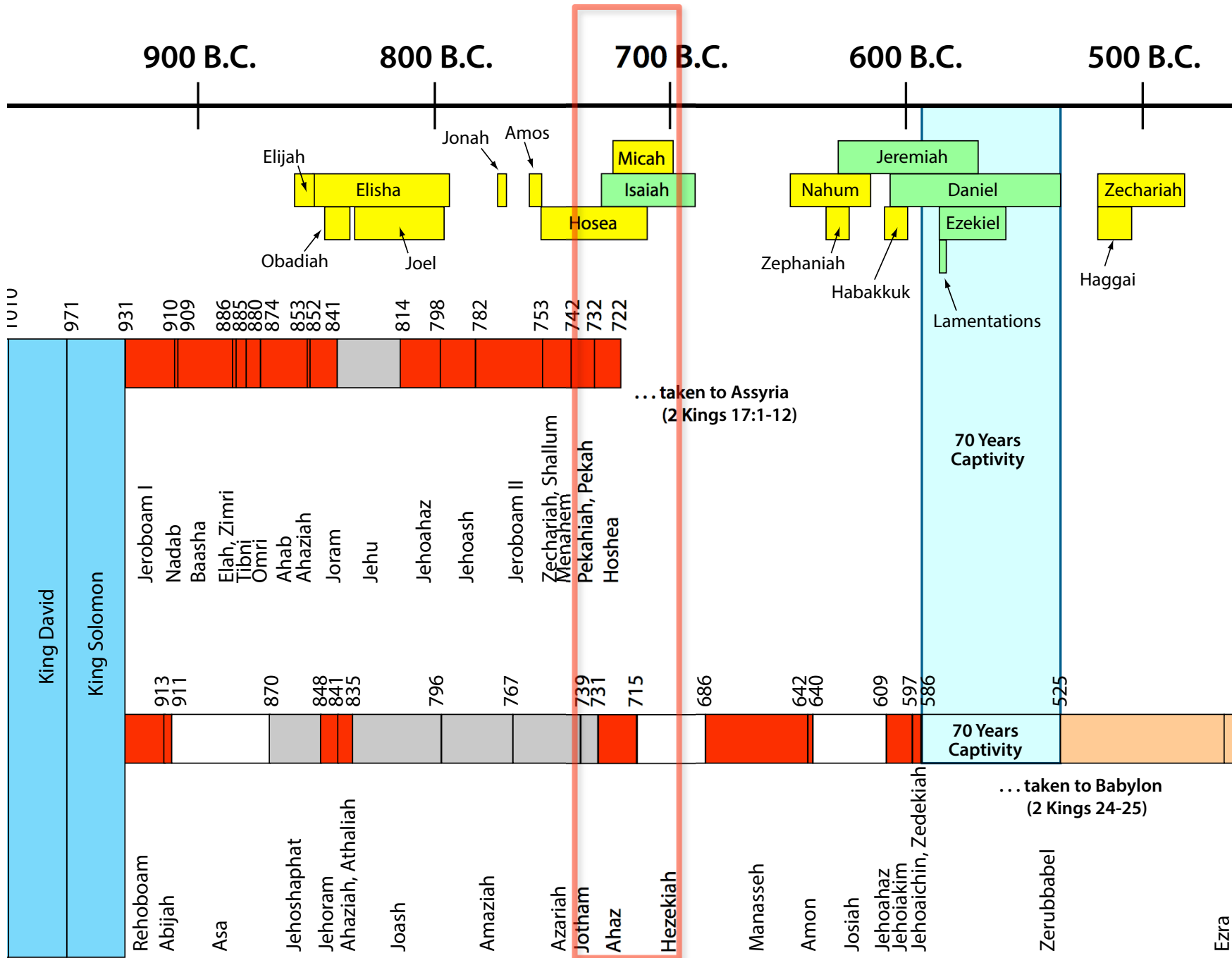

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- ***Baldness was forbidden (Lev. 21:5)***
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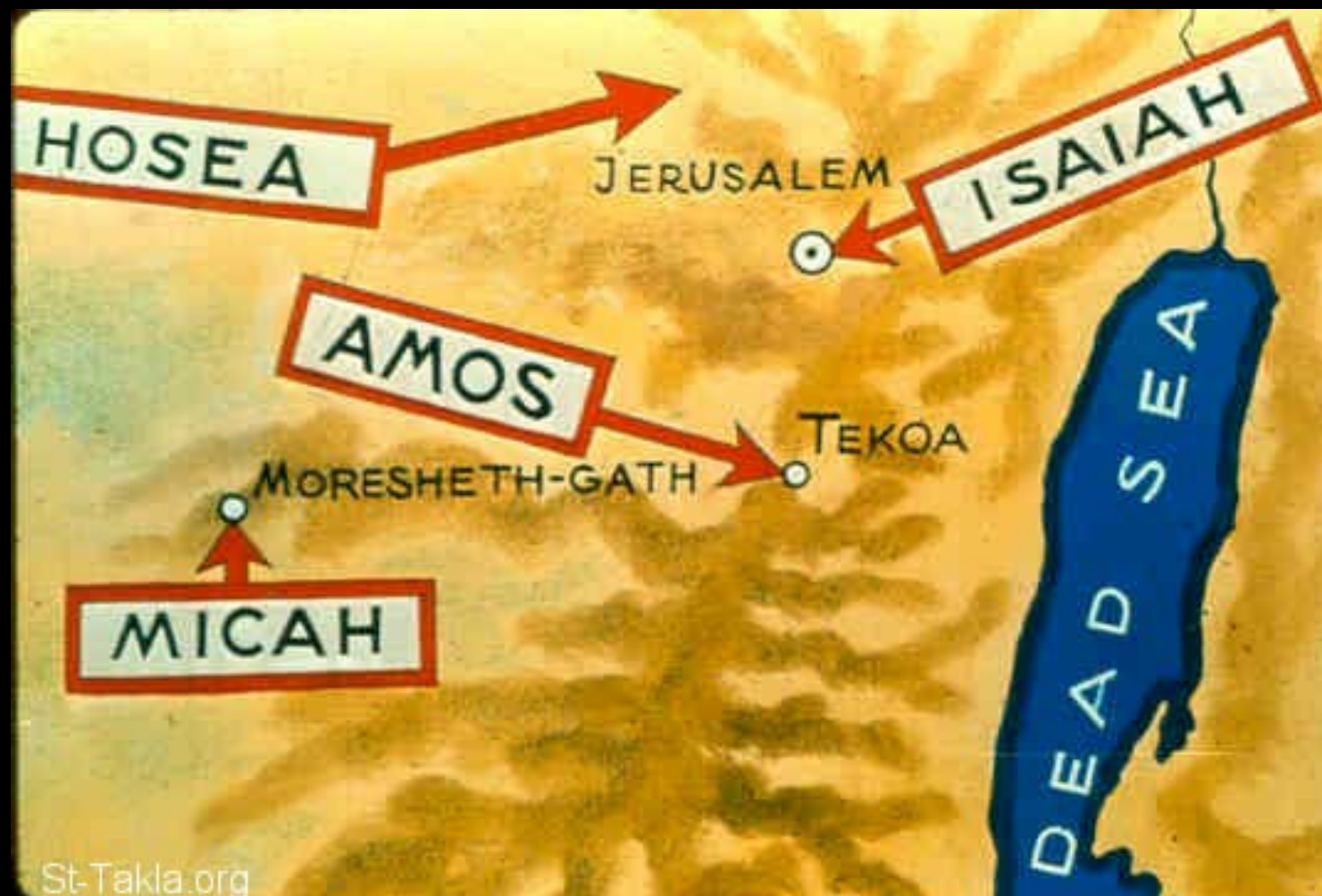
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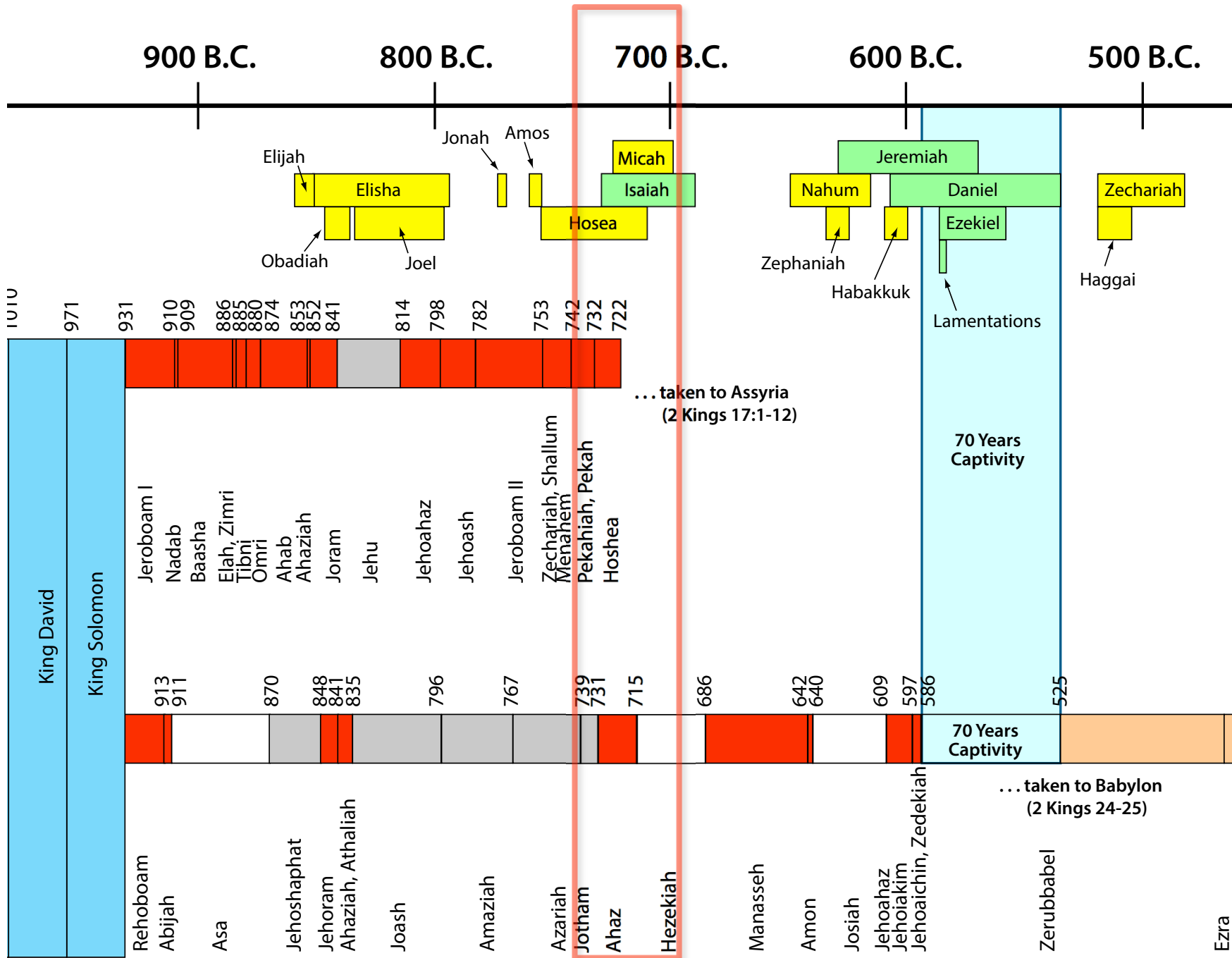
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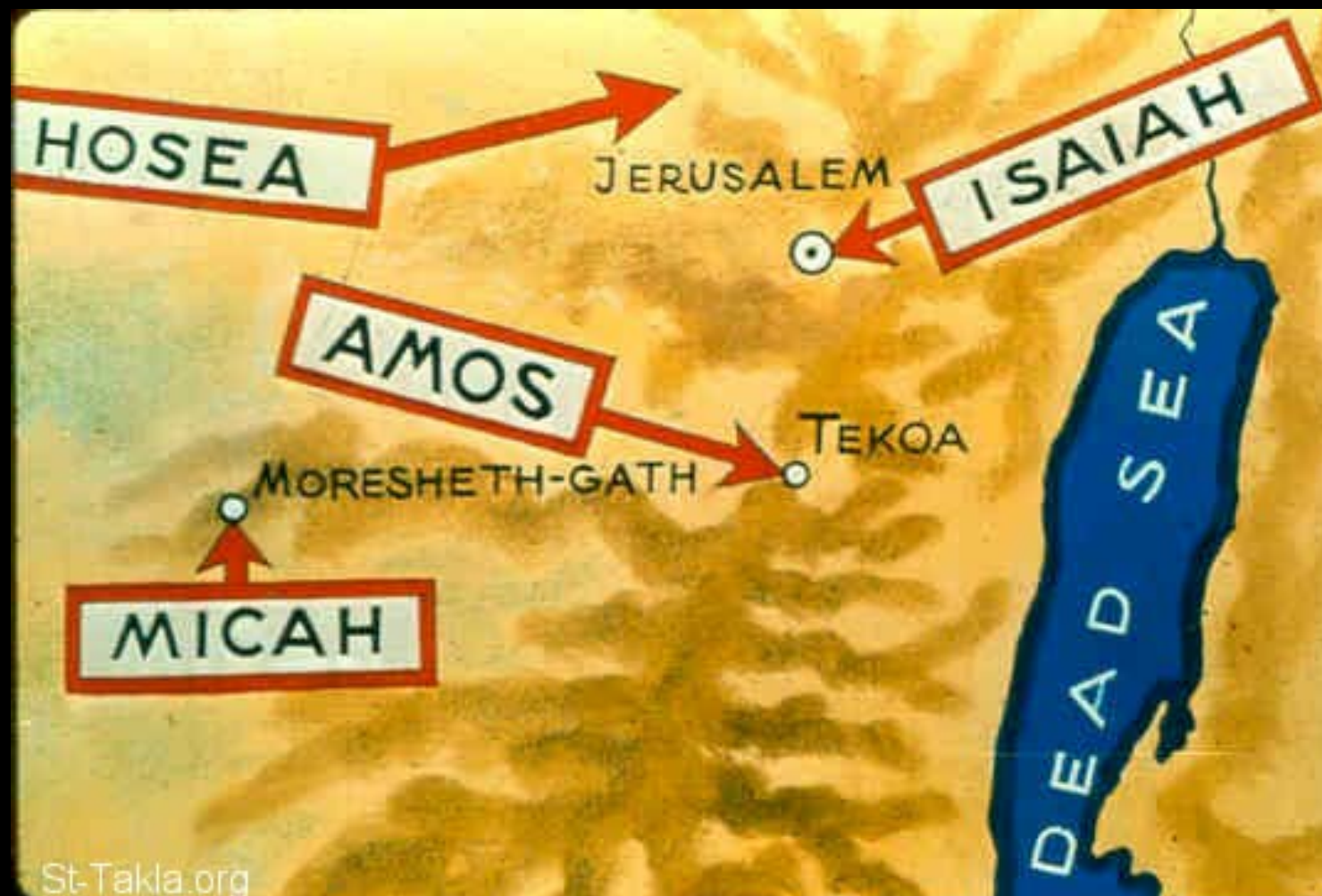
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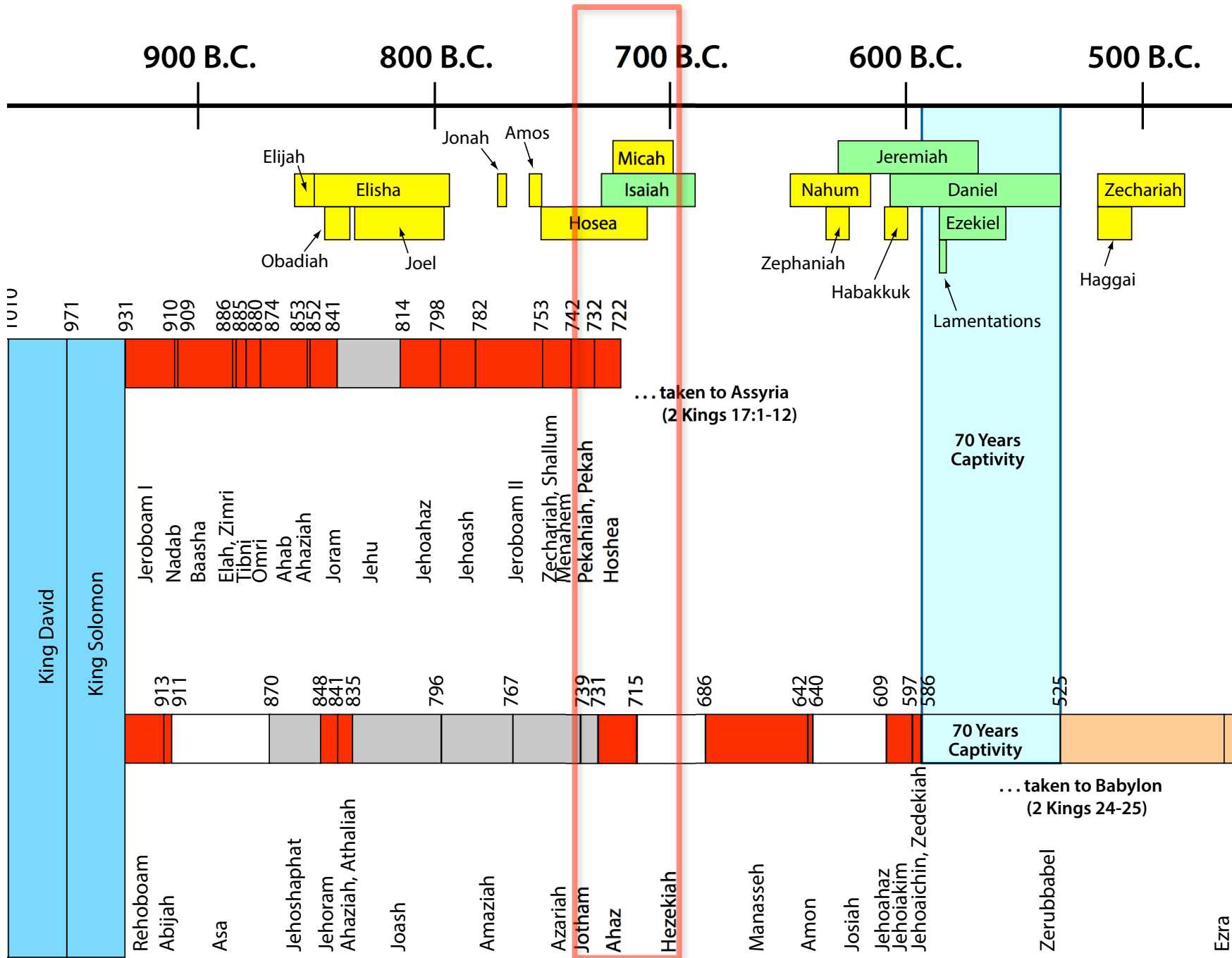
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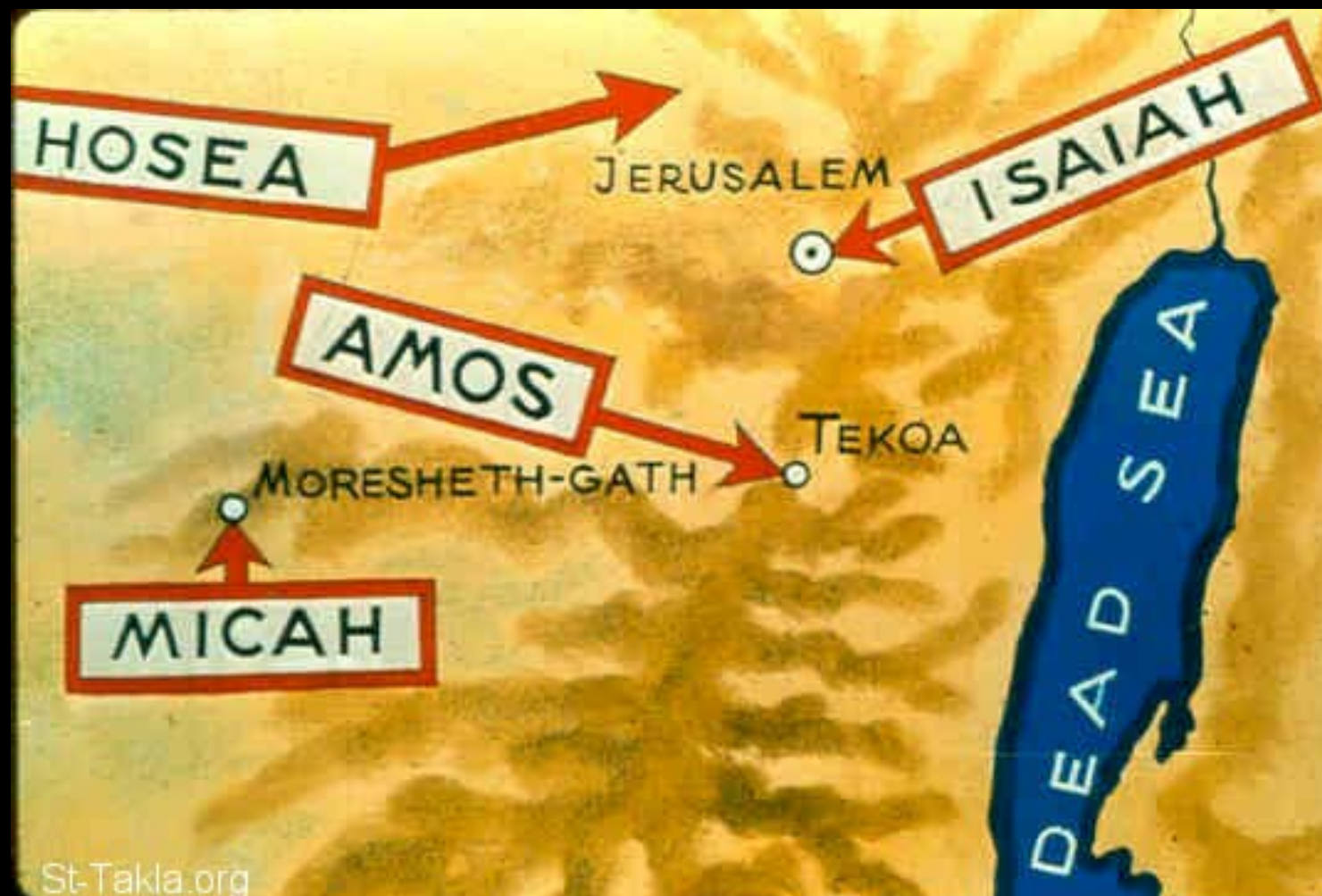
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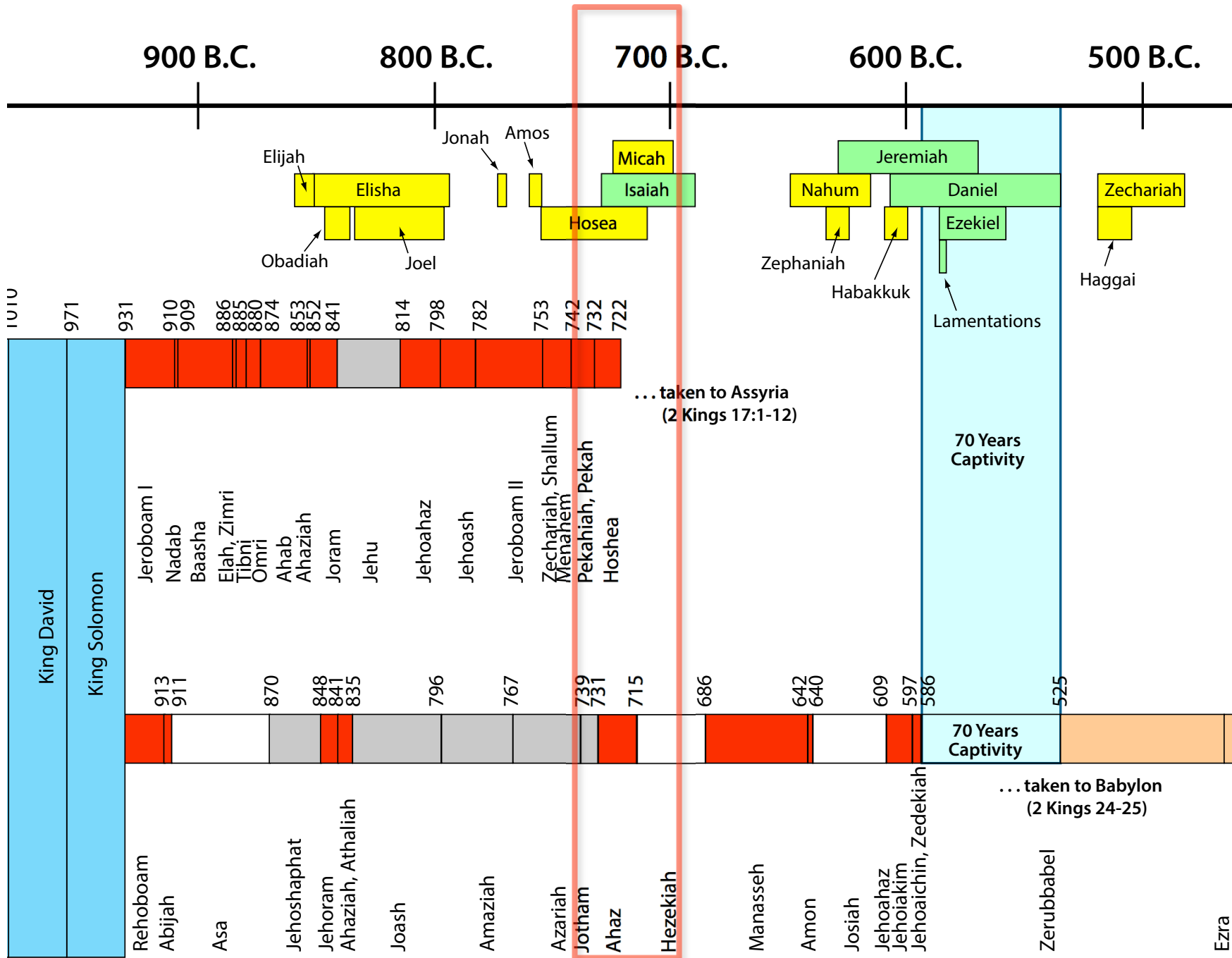
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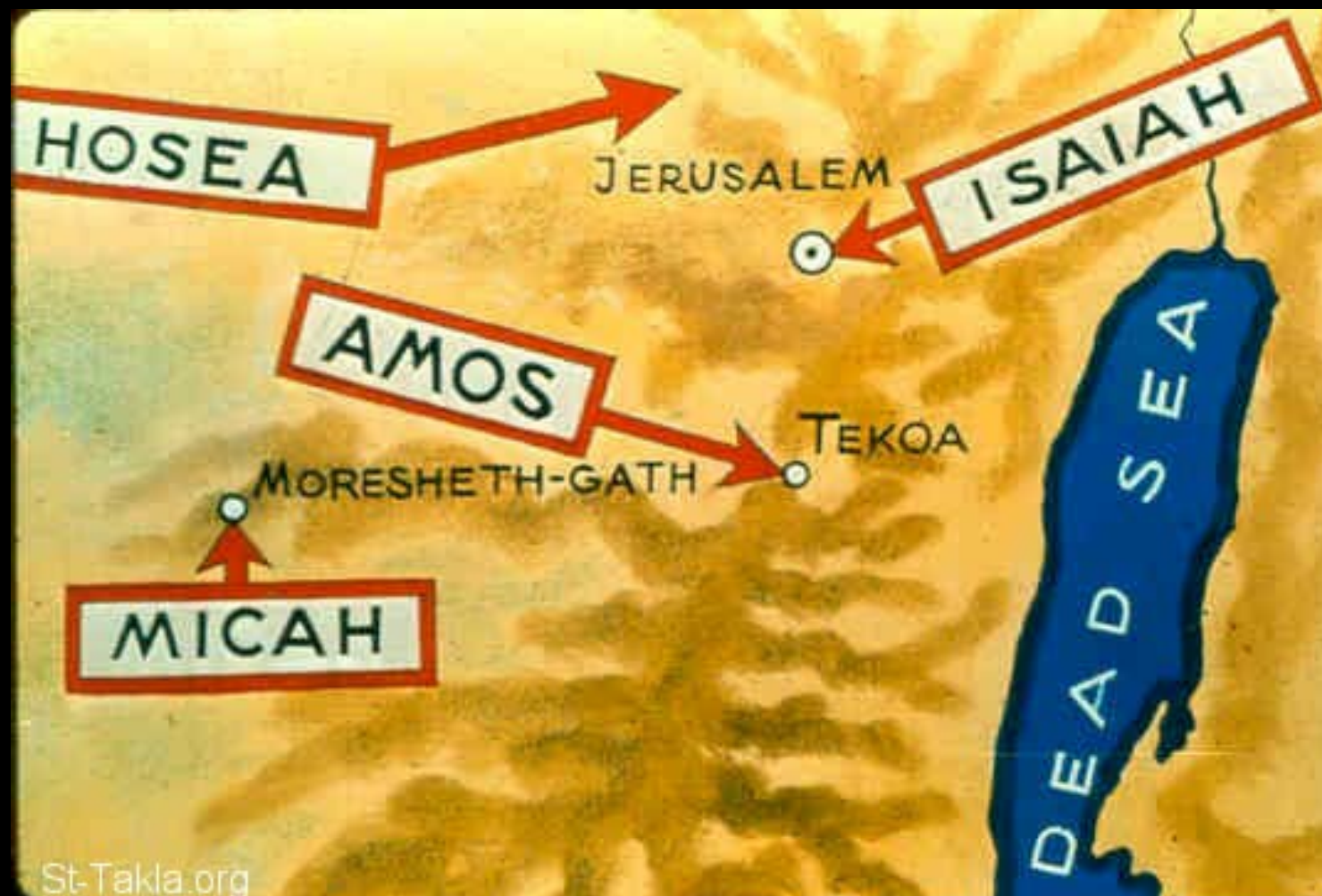
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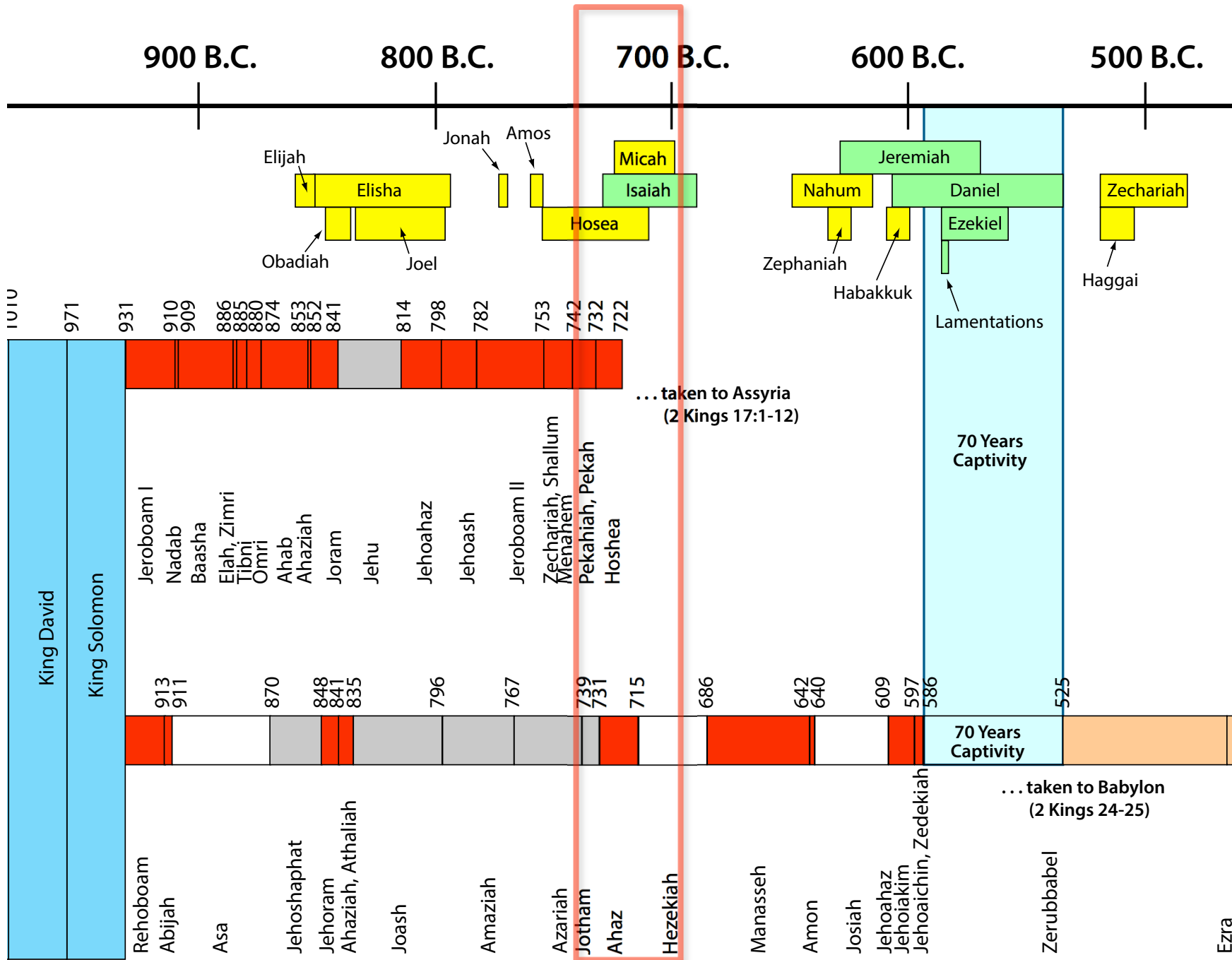
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
