


Call To Biblical Repentance Zechariah 1:1-6

The Kings and Prophets




Date of Zechariah: 480-470 B.C. Zechariah 1:1

- First prophecy was given in 520 B.C.
 - 2nd Year of Darius I . . . v.1
 - 8th month . . . v.1
 - 1st day . . . v. 1

Zechariah's and Haggai's Prophecies Overlap

2nd Year of Darius I




Date of Zechariah: 480-470 B.C.

Zechariah 1:1; 7:1

- Last prophecy given in: 480 470B.C.
 - 4ht Year of Darius I ... 7:1
 - 9th month . . . 7:1
 - 4th day . . . 7:1
- Zechariah covers 40 to 50 years
- Now: "Times of Gentiles" Luke 21:24

Born: In Babylon – Neh. 12:1, 16

Young man when he prophesized

Ministry: Prophet – Zech. 1:1

Priest – Neh. 12:1, 12 – 16

Member of Great Council – tradition

Author Is Zechariah

Ministry: Contemporary of Prophet Haggai

- Ezra 5:1-2; 6:14

Death:

Jesus said that he was murdered the between temple and altar

Eight Visions: As the angel of the Lord



Zech. 14:9 - King over the earth

Lord Was Angry With Your Fathers

Zechariah 1:2 - 3

1:2 - Lord was extremely angry

1:3 - Therefore, return to the Lord . . .

Lord Calls For Repentance

Zechariah 1:4 - 5

- 1:4 Israel ignored the prophets
 - God calls them to repent

- 1:5 All of them died.
 - Where are they?

Lord's Warnings Came True! Zechariah 1:6

- 1:6 Israel was punished
 - Then Israel repented
