

#### 1st & 2nd Vision In Zechariah

Zechariah 1:7 - 21

1<sup>st</sup> Vision – Promise that the glories of Israel will be restored

**2<sup>nd</sup> Vision** – Explains what God will do with the Gentiles that rule the land of Palestine

- "Lifted up" introduces another vision
- Two questions:
  - Who is the man?
  - The measuring line is symbolic of what?

 To measure Jerusalem means that the city is being rebuilt.

The man speaks to Zechariah

The man is the Angel of the Lord

Another angel approaches

- New angel speaks to the Angel of the Lord
- Jerusalem will be at peace
- Jerusalem will not need walls

- God will protect Israel
  - Ex. 13:22
- Prince of Peace will rule Isa. 9:6-7
- "For I" emphatic "I" . . . Great I AM
  - Ex. 3:1-2, 14

- Prophet Zechariah speaks
- Flee!

- Prophet Zechariah speaks
- Ho, Zion! Escape!

- "After glory"
  - Lord God will keep His glory .
  - . . Reputation
- "He has sent Me"
  - refers to Lord of Hosts (v. 9)
- Verse 8 reveals Lord of Hosts sent Me

- This is a reference to the Trinity
   Isa. 48:16
- Apple of His eye
   Deut. 32:10

Zechariah 2:10

- Sing of joy!
  - I am coming!
  - I dwell with you!

**Zechariah 2:11 - 13** 

- Many nations will come!
  - I dwell with you!
  - I restore Israel
  - I will restore Jerusalem
- Be silent . . .
