When I was just a little girl I asked my mother, what will I be Will I be pretty, will I be rich Here's what she said to me.


Que Sera, Sera,

Ecclesiastes 3:1

"Appointed time"



→ "definite time"



"time for every event"



"event involving emotion"

Details About Emptiness of Labor

Ecclesiastes 3:2 - 8

Patterns in each verse:

- Two sentences
- Sentences are similar
- First part of each sentence contrasts to the last part of the sentence



Time: Birth, Die, Plant & Uproot

Ecclesiastes 3:2

Time to give birth — 1 Sam. 1:5-6; Gen. 29:31

Time to die – Ps. 90:9-11; Job 14:5

Time to plant – Acts 14:17

Time to uproot – Isa. 28:24

Time: Kill, Heal, Tear Down & Build

Ecclesiastes 3:3

Time to kill –

Lev. 24:17-22

Time to heal –

Occur when one is sick

Time to tear down - The old . . .

Time to build up - ... to build the new

Time: Weep, Laugh, Mourn & Dance

Ecclesiastes 3:4

Time to weep – Rom. 12:15

Time to laugh — Rom. 12:15

Time to mourn — When someone dies

Time to dance — When someone marries

Time: Stones & Hugging

Ecclesiastes 3:5

Time to throw stones & gather stones

 Appears to refer to sexual activity

Time to embrace & shun embracing

Expression of friendship & marital warmth

Time: Search, Lost, Keep & Throw

Ecclesiastes 3:6

Time to search and stop searching

Search for lost items & stop searching

Time to keep and throw away

 We buy something & later throw it away

Time: Sewing & Speech

Ecclesiastes 3:7

Time to tear apart & sew together

- Process of sewing

Time to be silent and to speak

- James 1:19. Quick to hear and slow to speak.

Time: Love, Hate, War & Peace

Time to love and hate
