The Symbols


Zechariah 6:1

Symbolic Meaning of Bronze

Components of tabernacle	Holiness • Ex. 26-39
Bonze Altar & Serpent	Judgment
Military armor	Strength • Judges 16:21
Bronze walls for protection	Protection • Jer. 1:18; 15:20

1st Chariot - Red horses . . . killing

2nd Chariot - Black horses . . . famine

3rd Chariot - White horses . . . victory

4th Chariot - Dappled horses . . . death

Zechariah 6:4 - 7


- Four spirits of heaven . . .

Zechariah 6:4 - 7


- Black & white horses . . .
