- Are they willing to be baptized into Christ . . . submission to Christ – v. 38





The Gospel & Our Response


- Jesus died for our sins

What Is The Gospel?

- 1. History & miracles of Jesus is God
- 2. Jesus died on the cross
- 3. Jesus was raised up
- 4. Prophesies about Christ
- 5. Jesus ascended to heaven

What Must People Do?

- 1. Believe they are sinners John 8:24; Romans 3:23
- 2. Be repentant of their sins. Acts 3:19
- 3. Believe in Jesus Christ as Savior Romans 10:9-10
- 4. Yield to Him as Lord Romans 10:9-11
- 5. Tell Him that you want to saved Romans 10:13

The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart — that is, the word of faith which we are preaching, that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation. For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes in Him will not be disappointed."

Method For Presenting The Gospel?

- 1. Speak to large groups
- Speak one-on-one with people.

Preparation For Sharing The Gospel

- 1. Pray for boldness Acts 4:29-30
- 2. Pray for yourself and others Luke 10:1-3
- 3. Walk in the Spirit Galatians 5:16
- 4. Use scripture Isaiah 55:11; Hebrews 4:12

Encouraging Words

- 1. We are only responsible to preach the gospel not to cause them to believe. 1 Corinthians 3:6-9
- 2. There is a reward for sharing the gospel. Daniel 12:3

How then will they call on Him in whom they have not believed? How will they believe in Him whom they have not heard? And how will they hear without a preacher? How will they preach unless they are sent? Just as it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news of good things!" However, they did not all heed the good news; for Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our report?" So faith comes from hearing, and hearing by the word of Christ.
