

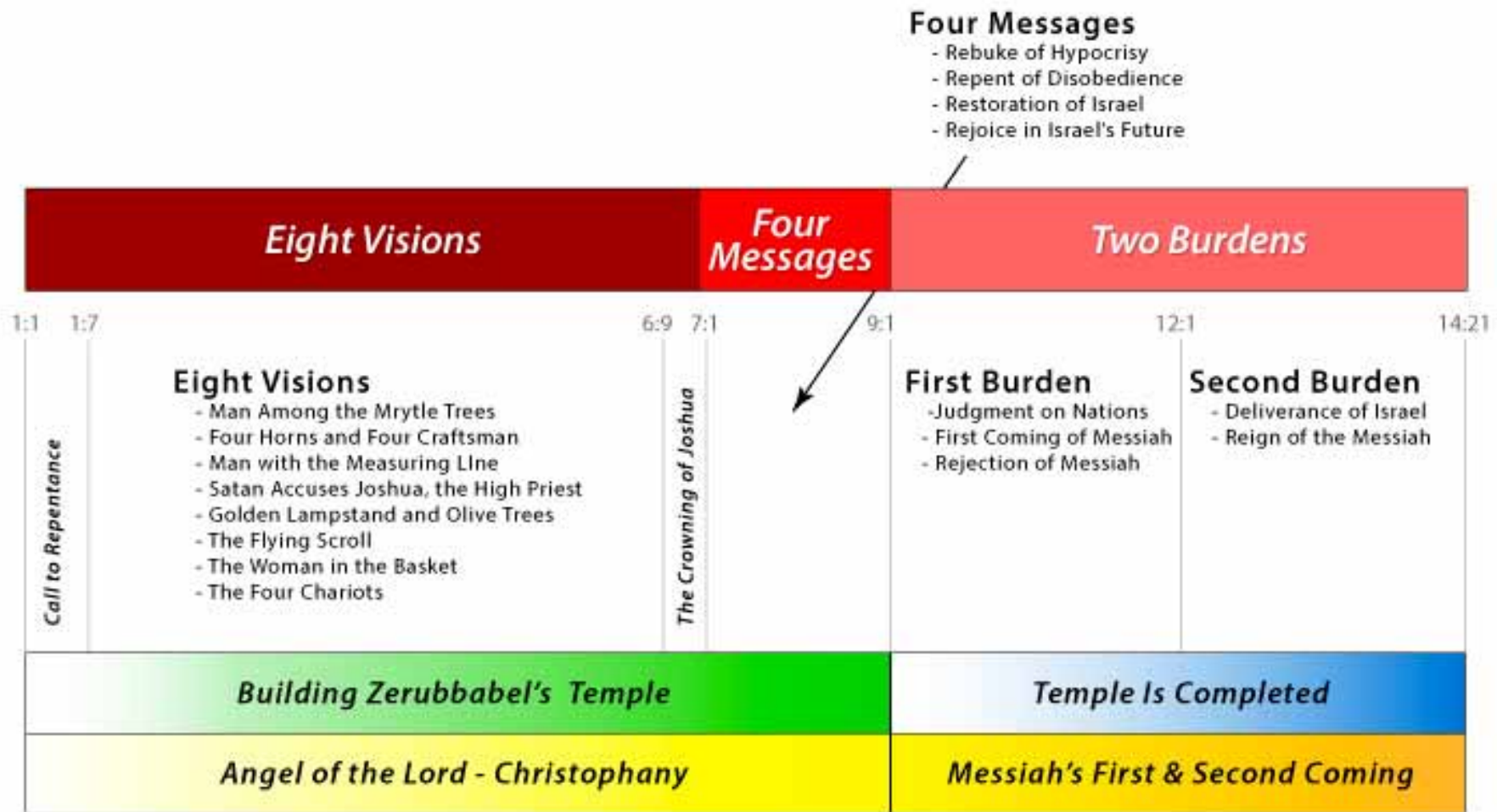

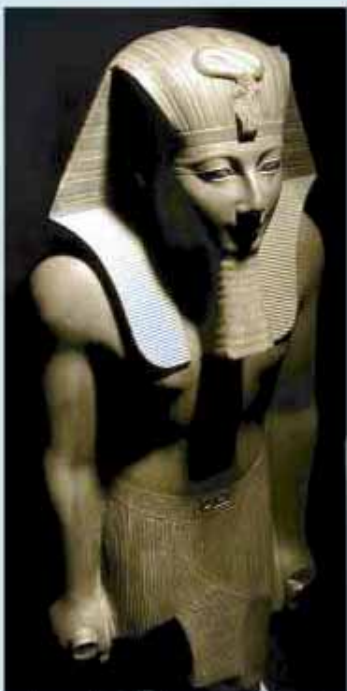

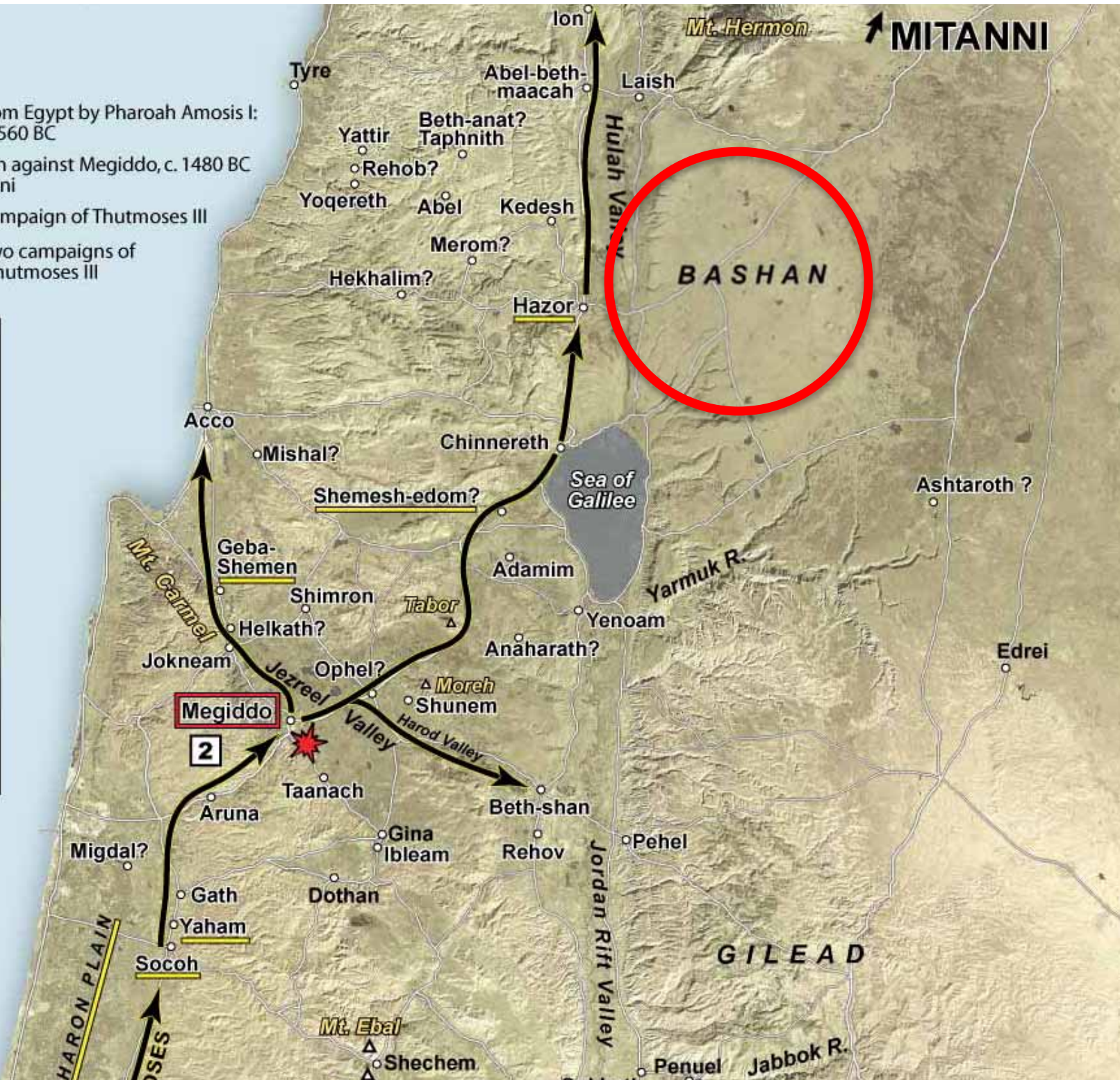

- Yaham Places mentioned in two campaigns of Amenhotep II, son of Thutmoses III

- ***Forest fire starts in Lebanon***

- ***Picture of the destruction of Israel***
- ***Religious leaders and youth are ruined***

Zechariah Commissioned

Zechariah 11:4 - 6

- v. 4***
- ***Zechariah plays a roles as if in a play***
 - ***He is the only actor***
 - ***He plays the role of a shepherd***
 - ***He plays the role of the Messiah***
 - ***The flock is Israel (Jer. 23:2; Ezek. 34:6)***

Zechariah Commissioned

Zechariah 11:4 - 6

v. 5

- ***A difficult verse to understand***
- ***Who buys Israel?***
- ***Romans conquered nations and then sold the people as slaves.***
- ***Romans apparently gave credit to God for their wealth.***
- ***Jewish leaders did not care!***

Zechariah Commissioned

Zechariah 11:4 - 6

v. 6

- ***Therefore God had no pity.***
- ***Zech. 9:8 – God protected Israel against Grecian Army***
- ***Zechariah was written ~ 470 B.C.***
- ***Greece invaded ~ 331 B.C.***
- ***Roman army invaded ~ 146 B.C.***

Zechariah Role Plays

Zechariah 11:7 - 14

v. 7 - ***Two staves:***

- ***Favor – “gracious or favor”***
- ***Union – “union or harmony”***

Zechariah Role Plays

Zechariah 11:7 - 14

- v. 8** - ***Most difficult verse in chapter 1***
- ***Who are the shepherds – Jer. 2:8***
 - ***Religious leaders rejected Christ
(Matt. 12:27-32)***
 - ***Christ rejected the religious
leaders
(Matt. 13:13-15; 22:23-45; 23:3ff)***

Zechariah Role Plays

Zechariah 11:7 - 14

- v. 9** - ***Messiah stopped shepherding Israel
(Luke 19:41 – 44)***

- v. 10** - ***1st Staff broken***
 - ***Covenant was broken***
 - ***King and kingdom delayed***

Zechariah Role Plays

Zechariah 11:7 - 14

- v. 11*** - ***Remnant would understand***
- v. 12*** - ***Wages does Messiah (sarcasm)***
- v.13*** - ***Wages thrown away***
 - ***(Matt. 26:14-16; 27:3-10; Acts 1:16-19)***

v. 4 - 2nd Staff broken
