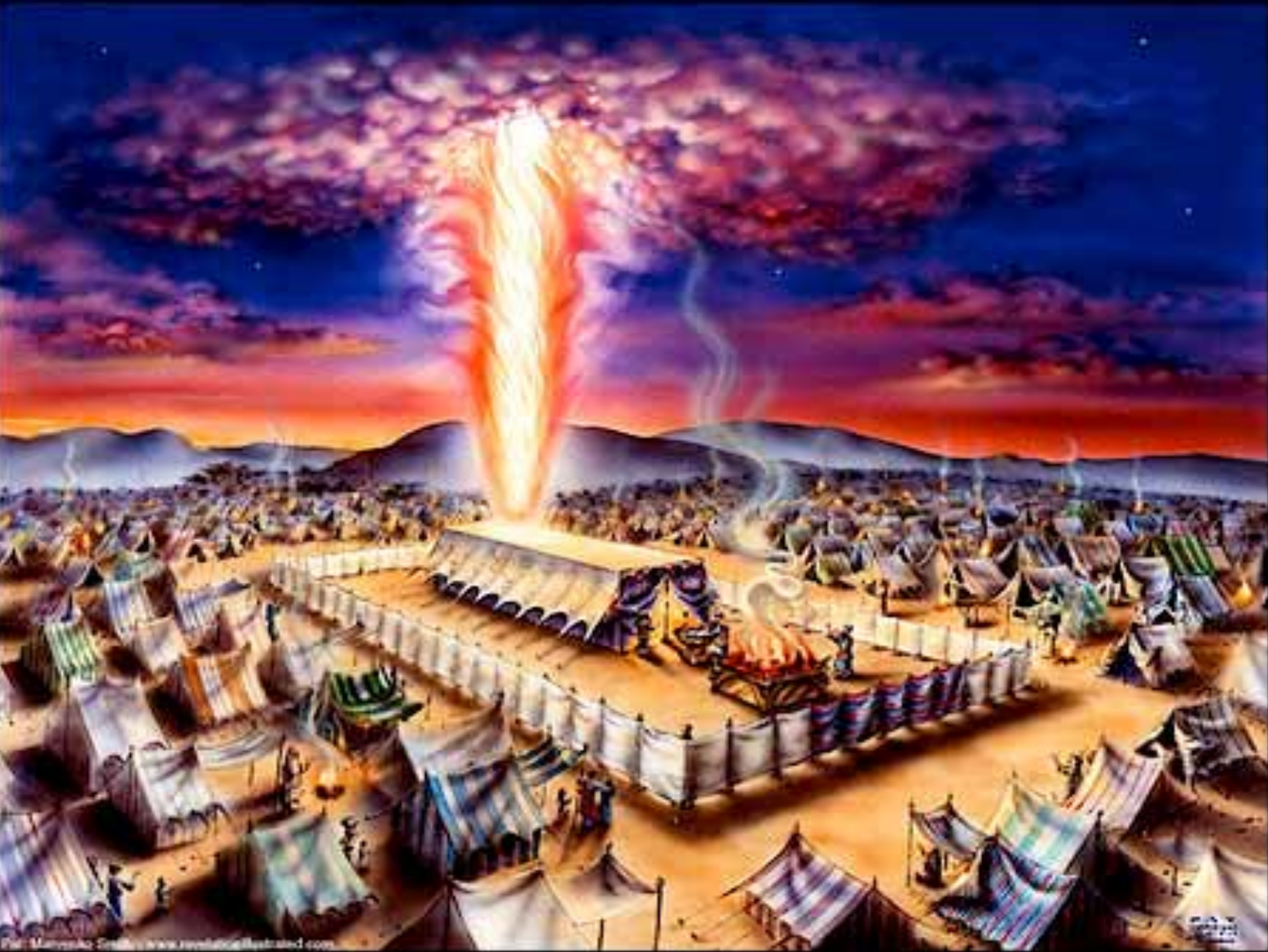

Grain/Meal Offering - 1

Leviticus 2:1 - 16

- v. 1**
- This is a gift to the Lord***
 - Symbolizes dedication***
 - Usually offered with the burnt offering***
 - Four different types of offerings***

 - Offering from the field***
 - Offered to the Lord***
 - Each ingredient had symbolism***



Grain/Meal Offering - 2

Leviticus 2:1 - 16

- v. 2** - ***Worshipper brings the gift***
 - ***Gives handful to the priest***
 - ***No animals sacrificed***

- v. 3** - ***Rest of the offering was given to priest***

- v. 4** - ***2nd Option – bake it in an oven***
- V. 5-6** - ***3rd Option – grille it***
- v. 7** - ***4th Option – fry it***

Grain/Meal Offering - 3

Leviticus 2:1 - 16

v. 8-10 - Sacrificial process to be followed

v. 11 - No leaven or honey

v. 12-16 - Fruit could be offered

v. 13 - Salt must be added

Peace Offering - 1

Leviticus 3:1 - 17

- v. 1** – ***This offering seeks a relationship with the Lord***
- ***Symbolizes reconciliation with God***
 - ***Usually offered with the burnt offering***
 - ***Three different types of offerings***
 - ***Offered to the Lord***
 - ***Most loved sacrifice***
 - ***Requirement relaxed: male or female animal***

Peace Offering - 2

Leviticus 3:1 - 17

- v. 2** - ***Worshipper lays hands on animal***
- ***Worshipper kills the animal***
- ***Priest sprinkles blood around altar***

- v. 3** - ***All the fat was offered***

- v. 4** - ***Notice order: fat, animal, wood and fire.***

Peace Offering - 3

Leviticus 3:1 - 17

v. 6-11 - Option #2 – Lamb could be offered

v. 12-17 - Option # 3 – Goat could be offered
