



Leviticus 4:1 – 5:13

- v. 1 For unintentional sins of commission
- v. 3 If the High Priest sins
- v. 4-6 Blood sprinkled before the veil
 - Blood placed on horns of in the Altar of Incense






THE TABERNACLE TENT

The entire tent was 45 feet (13.7 m) long, 15 feet (4.6 m) wide, and 15 feet (4.6 m) high. It was a wooden skeletal structure, overlaid with gold, with no solid roof or front wall (Ex. 26:15–29). Five wooden bars (overlaid with gold) passed through rings attached to each frame (Ex. 26:26–30).

The Most Holy Place was a 15-foot (4.6-m) cube, containing only the ark of the covenant (Ex. 25:10–22; 37:1–9). It was here that Yahweh would descend to meet with his people in a cloud theophany (divine appearance). The high priest could enter only once a year, on the Day of Atonement (see note on Heb. 9:7).

Leviticus 4:1 – 5:13

- v. 7 Blood on Altar of Burnt Offering
- v. 8-12 Remove and put outside of camp
- v. 13-21 If entire congregation sins
- v. 22-26 If Leader sins
- v. 27-35 If common person sins

- v. 1 Unintentional sins of omission
 - Dishonest witness
- v. 2 Touched unclean thing
- v. 3 Touched unclean human
- v. 4 Swore falsely

v. 5 - 13 – The Sin Offering for unintentional sins of omission

Leviticus 5:14 – 6:7

- v. 14 16 Unfaithful and unintentional sins against the holy things of God
- v. 17-19 Unfaithful and unintentional sins otherwise
- 6:1-7 Unfaithful sins
