Paul's Reveals He Is A Christian 1 John 1:6-9


- v. 6 7 Non-Christian who claims they are a Christian but they continue to willfully sin
- v. 8 Non-Christian who thinks they are perfect do not need to change
- v. 9 The Christian admits they still sin

dioko = "to run, to press on"




Paul Says That He Is Running

Don't Look At Someone Else




Reaching For the Prize
