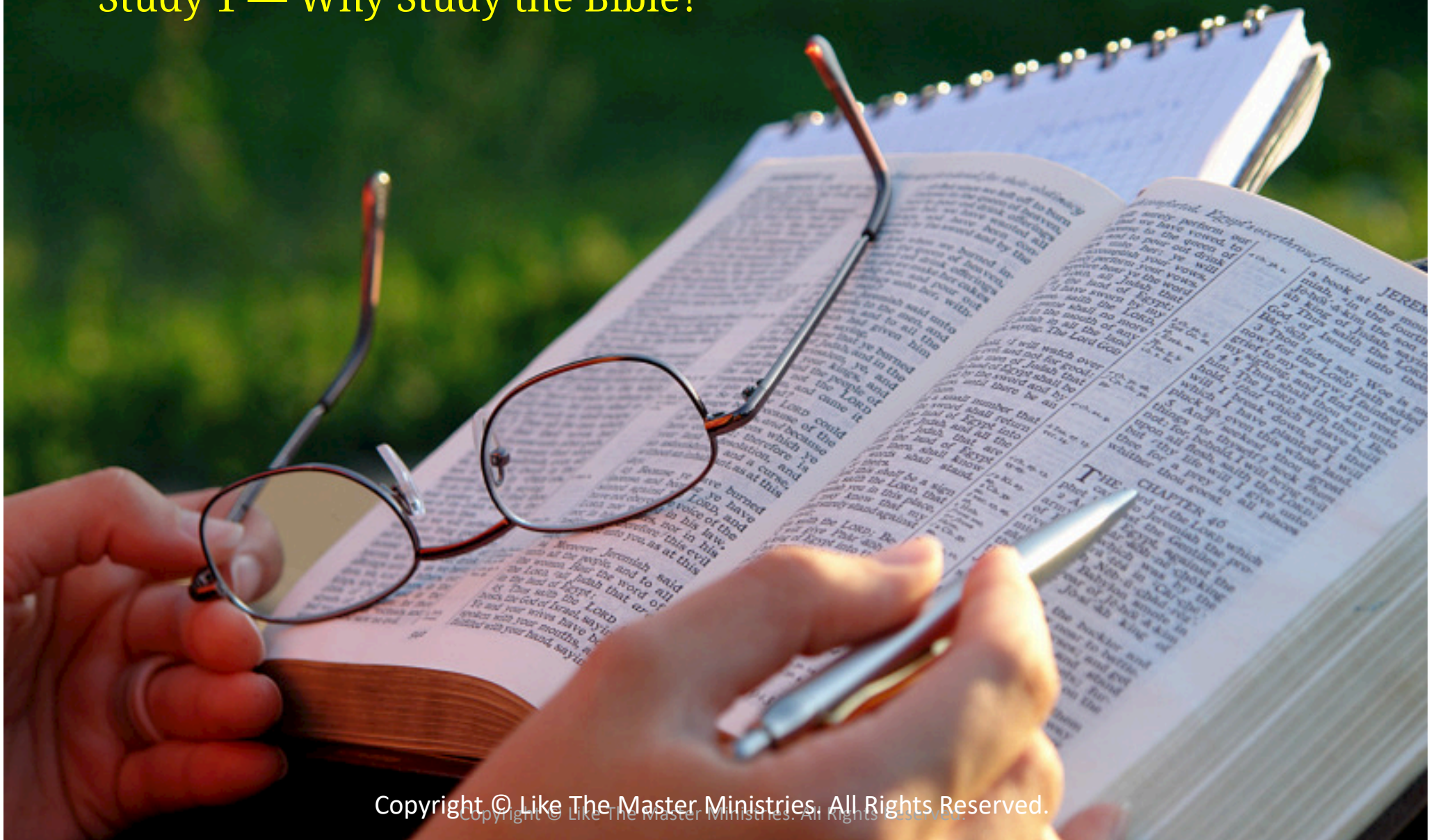

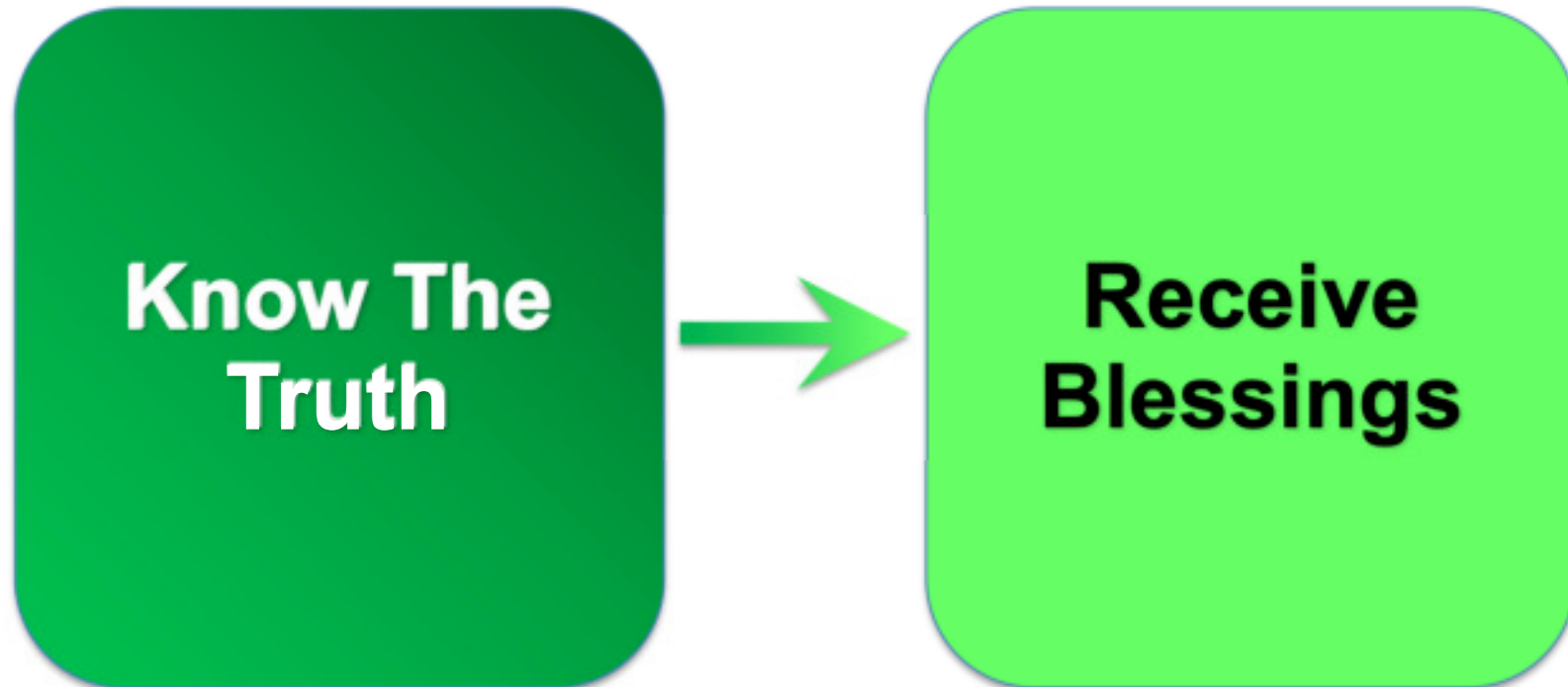

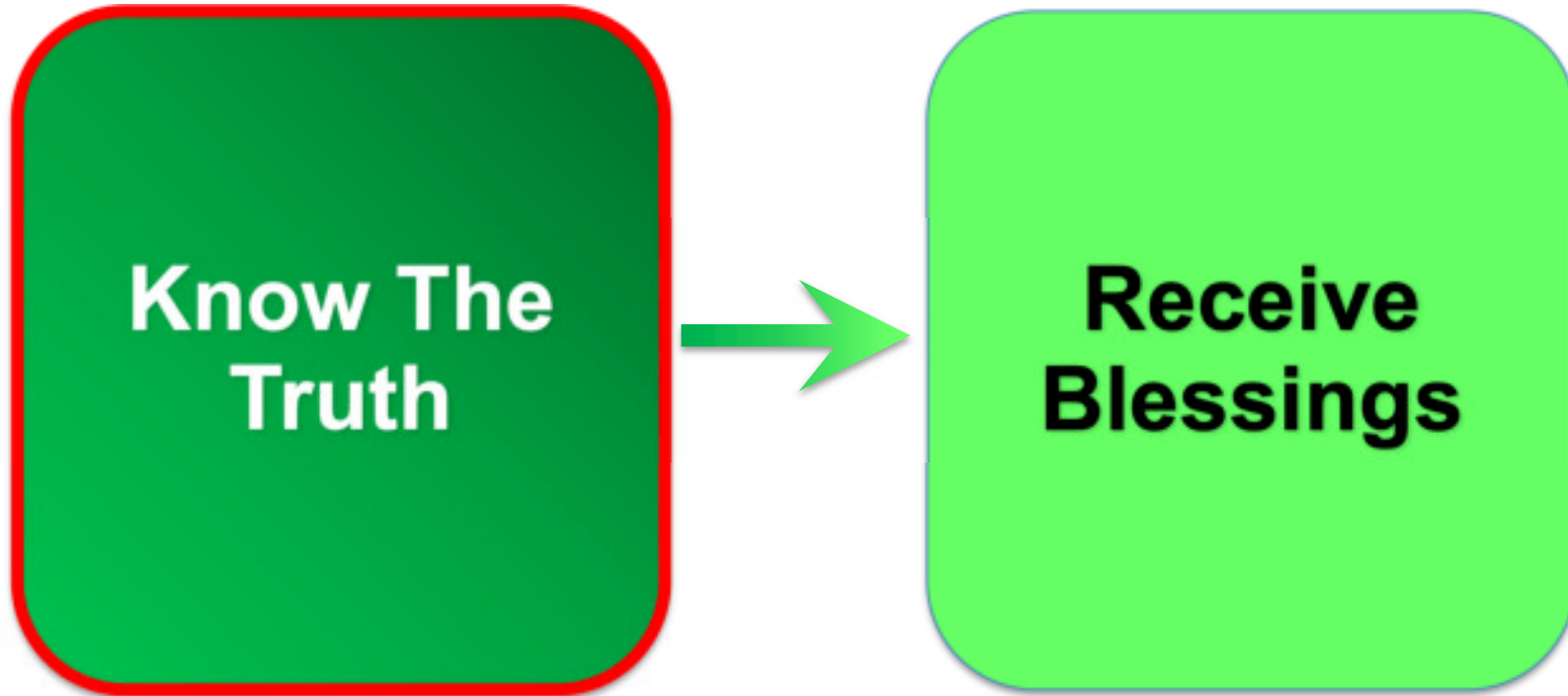

Galatians 3:26-27	X Not About Baptism				All sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For all of you who were baptized into Christ . . .
Ephesians 2:8-9	X				For by grace you have been saved through faith . . . not as a result of works . . .
1 Timothy 1:16	X				As an example for those who would believe in Him for eternal life . . .
Titus 3:5	Not About Baptism				He saved us . . . by the washing of regeneration and renewing by the Holy Spirit . . .
James 2:23	X				AND ABRAHAM BELIEVED GOD, AND IT WAS RECKONED TO HIM AS RIGHTEOUSNESS . . .
1 Peter 1:9	X				Obtaining as the outcome of your faith the salvation of your souls . . .
1 Peter 3:21				X	Now saves us - baptism (not the removal of the filth of the flesh . . .

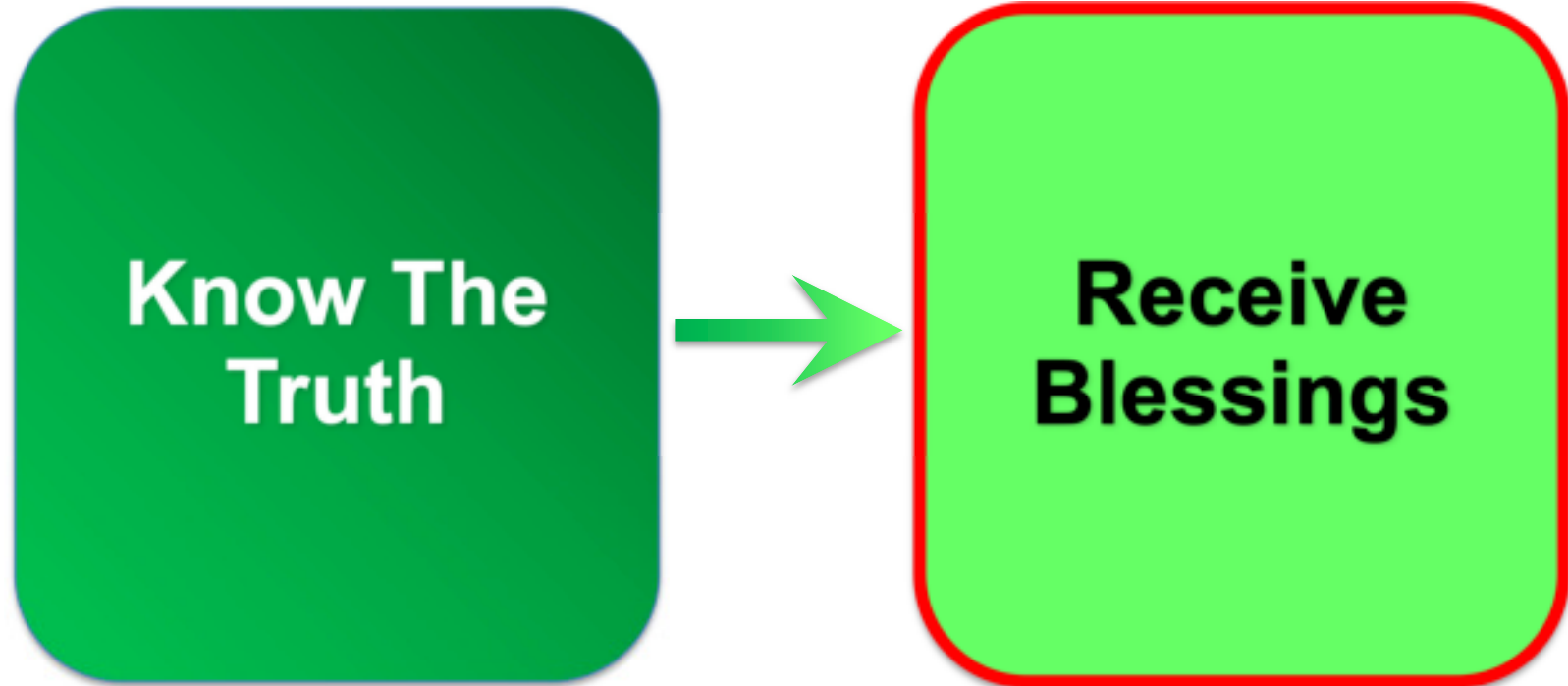
