
SYROPHOENICIAN


"Syrian language" (2 Kings 18:26; Isa. 36:11; both in KJV). A more correct rendering of this Heb. term ('ărāmît) is Aramaic (which see.)

syrophoenicia (si-rō-pe-ni'shan). A general name (Mark 7:26) of a female inhabitant of the northern portion of Phoenicia, popularly called Syrophoenicia, by reason of its proximity to Syria and its absorption by conquest into that kingdom. The woman of Syrophoenicia appealed to Jesus to heal her daughter, who was possessed with a demon. When she came near to Him and worshiped, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord," He replied, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the dogs" (Math. 15:22). Whether this was to try her faith, or to show that at that time His work and mission were among Israel, is hard to determine. Her faith, however,
