Last Five Kings of the Kingdom of Judah

King Josiah*

640 - 609 B.C. Became king at 8 years Reigned 31 years Was a good king



King Jehoahaz*

609 B.C.
Became king at 23 years
Reigned 3 months
Taken captive to Egypt
Was an evil king
(2 Kings 23:31-32)

Also known as:
- Shallum

King Jehoiakim*

609-598 B.C.
Became king at 25 years
Reigned 11 years
Never taken captive
Was an evil king
(2 Kings 23:34-37)

Also known as:
- Eliakim

598-597 B.C.

King Jehoichin

Dec. 9, 598 B.C. - Mar. 16, 597
Became king at 18 years
Reigned 3 months
Taken captive to Babylon
Was an evil king
(2 Kings 24:8-15)

Also known as:

- leconiah
- Coniah

Zedekiah*

597 - 586 B.C.
Became king at 21 years
Reigned 11 years
Taken captive to Babylon
Was an evil king
(2 Kings 24:17-25:7)

Also known as:

- Mattaniah

*1 Chronicles 3:14-15 lists four sons for Josiah. First son was Johanan, but he never reigned as a king.
